The last day of Summer Learning/Reading Program had 61 attendee's Fantastic. The five Brown County Library Directors, plus library patrons who strongly supporting us, about 40 people, met with the Brown County Commissioners to request increased funding for 2018. Then each of us had an opportunity to tell a little about our needs and programs. They realized that last year's 5% increase was our first raise in 10 years and previous to that we had decreases. The plan is to increase us 5% again providing taxes come in to cover it.

Saturday, August 19 the W.O.T. did a great job sponsoring a Taco Feed to benefit the library renovation/move. There was a poor turn out; however we did make about \$1200. Final figure isn't in yet, so that was great. Thanks to WOT & community members attending.

Saturday, September 9<sup>th</sup> is the Fireman's Annual Pork Chop Fund Raising dinner. In conjunction with this is Neighbor Hood Night Out. See you at the city park from 4-7. The library will have a table there. We have had a number of books donated that are to given free to kids, will also have free Freezie's and free temporary tattoos. This is the night we will draw for the quilt donated to us for fund raising by the Zion W-ELCA. Need not be present to win. You will still have an opportunity to get tickets that night.

Thursday, September 14 at 6:00 pm is Kids Night out at the library. Tuesday, September 19<sup>th</sup> our Seasoned Citizen Book Club resumes after summer break.
