Absentee/Mail ballots can be returned <u>until</u> 8 p.m. on Election Day. ** “Direct balloting”, an alternative in-person absentee voting procedure where a voter can choose to cast their ballot directly into the ballot counter is offered the last 18 days prior to Election Day. *** <u>On Election Day</u> , the Auditor-Treasurer Office will be open for <u>Mail Ballot Precincts</u> from 7 a.m. – 8 p.m. to vote using either mail ballot or ballot counter procedures.
