

Hanska City Council – Regular Meeting

October 14th 2024

Regular meeting was called to order by Mayor Vee at 6:00pm. Members present Vee, Kjelshus, Miller, and Larson. Members absent: Geiger

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Kjelshus moved to approve the agenda. Seconded by Larson. Motion passed.

Open Citizens Comments: Yvette Mosenden has been having water filter issues. Wondering what could be causing her to have to replace her filters every two weeks while previously only having to replace every three months. Tauer reported that we are working to fix our main well and are on a back up system but it has been tested and passed. Tauer stated that he recently flushed fire hydrants and that could be the cause. Council encouraged Mosenden to check with neighbors if they are having similar issues and to report if there is no change or improvement in water quality and filter issue.

Kjelshus moved to approve minutes from the September 9th 2024 meeting. Seconded by Larson. Motion passed.

Miller moved to approve the minutes from the special meeting held September 23rd 2024 meeting. Seconded by Larson.

Miller moved to approve City claims. Seconded by Larson. Motion passed.

Library – Pick gave the report. Library is going to be open extra hours MEA weekend with added activities. Library was approved a \$2000 grant from the New Ulm Area Foundation for the Summer Reading program in 2025. There will be a pumpkin activity at the library and are working on a “No Smashing Pumpkins” Club. Tauer and Pick discussed having the club to dispose of the pumpkins at the compost site. Furnace bids discussed and will with contacting Nielsen and GSM for new quotes for furnace only. Hopes to have it fixed as soon as possible.

Motion was made by Larson to get the two quotes from Nielsen and GSM for Library and move forward with least expensive. Seconded by Miller. Motion passed.



Public works- Tauer’s report. Tauer will be out of office Wednesday October 16 – 18th. Working on removing branches and


City Clerk Haala – City Clerk Haala – working on training to familiarize herself with the position. Haala is working on getting access to financial accounts.
