

Hanska City Council – Regular Meeting

November 12th, 2024

6pm – Hanska Community Center

Regular meeting was called to order by Mayor Vee at 6:00pm. Members present Vee, Kjelshus, Miller, Geiger, and Larson. Members absent – none.

Geiger moved to approve the agenda. Seconded by Larson. Motion passed.

Open Citizens Comments: Yvette Mosenden is still having water filter issues. Brought in the last ones she changed hours before meeting. Wondering what could be causing her to have to replace her filters every two weeks while previously only having to replace every three months. Mary Stark is concerned with the snow being plowed to her side of the street (4th St E).

Matt Cole from Bolton and Menk gave an update on well. See attached notes.

Kjelshus moved to approve minutes from the October 14th 2024 meeting. Seconded by Miller. Motion passed.

Kjelshus moved to approve City claims. Seconded by Geiger. Motion passed.

Library – Pick gave the report. New furnace installed. Purchased a new vacuum as the old one quit working. Hanska Helpers is going well. Becky Vee is resigning from Library Board.

Fire Department – Larson gave report. Purchased a new truck, 6,000 miles. Purchase price just under \$60,000.00. Purchased new air packs.

Public Works – Tauer gave report. Branches and street sweep. Alley behind church paved – council agreed it funded by city and citizens whose properties line that alley. Tauer has about 20 meters to install. Not having good results with these meters, estimated \$16,000 to replace. Club house roof needs replacement. Insurance will not cover it if it is damaged before being repaired.

City Clerk Haala – City Clerk Haala – Larson motioned to pass Resolution 2024-8 Canvassing & Declaring Elections, Kjelshus seconded. Motion passed.

Would like to have a city credit card for online purchasing. Council agreed. Council would like to implement cleaning fee or deposit on club house and community center when rented. Being left a mess too many times.

Netzke bid came in for community center bell tower at \$15,000. Tauer thought he could repair it next spring without Netzke's help.

Geiger made a motion to adjourn, Larson seconded, meeting was adjourned at 7:12 pm
